## Refund Policies

Students officially withdrawing from PRCC during institutional and/or federal refund periods who receive federal financial aid are required in accordance with federal regulations to return "unearned" portions of federal funds to the financial programs from which aid was disbursed. Students who do not complete a period of enrollment may not "earn" all of their financial aid based on their date of withdrawal from the institution. The method of returning funds to federal programs is calculated using the federally mandated financial aid refund policy (Return of Title IV Refund Policy), in conjunction with the institutional refund policy with regard to tuition and fees. The student should be advised that this calculation may result in the student's owing a balance back to PRCC for funds that the institution has been required to return to federal agencies on behalf of the student or in a repayment owed to the U.S. Department of Education that the student must pay.
